much + incontable

Usaremos "much" con sustantivos incontables, o sea, con sustantivos que no puedan contarse.

Algunos ejemplos son cosas no concretas como emociones o ideas (amor, esfuerzo, etc), y también objetos que no puedan contarse por si solos como líquidos (agua, jugo, etc), productos graneados (azúcar, sal, etc) o productos que se adquieren por trozo (carne, queso, etc)

many + contable

Usaremos "many" con sustantivos contables, o sea, con sustantivos que puedan contarse como unidad.

Algunos ejemplos son personas, animales, u objetos concretos contables por unidad.

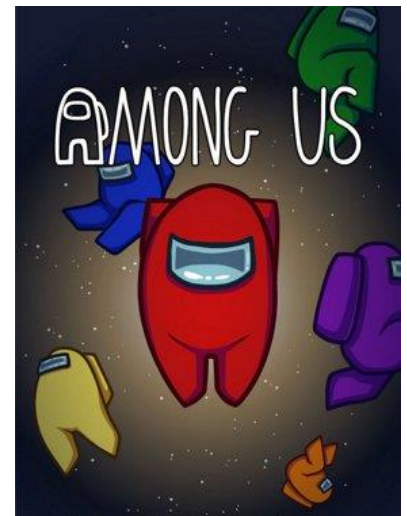


C) Bleaching and crazy hair colors:
