MODAL VERBS		
Type	Modal Verbs	Examples
ABILITY	Can, Could	<div><div>✿ David can speak three languages.</div><div>✿ He could speak fluent French when he was 5.</div></div>
PERMISSION	Can, Could, May	<div><div>✿ Can I sit in that chair please?</div><div>✿ Could I open the window?</div><div>✿ May I borrow your dictionary?</div></div>
ADVICE	Should	<div><div>✿ You should visit your dentist at least twice a year.</div><div>✿ You should try to lose weight.</div></div>
OBLIGATION	Must, Have to	<div><div>✿ I must memorize all of these rules about tenses.</div><div>✿ You have to take off your shoes before you get into the mosque.</div></div>
POSSIBILITY	Might, May, Could, Can	<div><div>✿ It looks nice, but it might be very expensive.</div><div>✿ Richard may be coming to see us tomorrow.</div></div>
